



GLASSES BUTTON – MASK ACCESSORY

INSTRUCTION MANUAL



If you've ever worn a mask with glasses, hearing aids, or just sensitive ears, you'll know how quickly everything behind your ears adds up.

These glasses buttons clip onto the arms of your glasses and give you a place to hook your mask instead. It takes the pressure off your ears, helps prevent rubbing, and keeps things more comfortable through longer wear.

Once they're on, they stay in place, so you can just hook your mask on and off as needed without readjusting each time.

Great for:

- Taking pressure off the ears when wearing masks
- Nurses, healthcare workers, and support staff
- Dental, clinical, and care environments
- Travel, flights, and public transport
- People managing illness, immunity, or ongoing health needs
- People who wear hearing aids
- Sensory sensitivities around the ears
- Preventing rubbing or soreness from mask elastic
- Long periods of mask wear
- Easy on and off mask use without adjusting
- Children and adults

Features:

- Button-style design that sits on the arms of your glasses
- Holds mask elastic off the ears
- Reduces pressure and crowding behind the ears
- Stays in place on your glasses once fitted
- Secured using elastic bands (requires tool to install)
- Lightweight and discreet for everyday wear

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Image Description: Small round black buttons designed to clip onto the arms of glasses. Shown attached near the ear, with mask elastic hooked onto the button instead of looping behind the ear.

Details:

Material: Plastic and Silicone

Size: 15mm x 8.8mm x 7.8mm

Weight: 5.9 grams

Package includes: 2x Glasses Buttons in Case

Age Guidance: Suitable for ages 3+; supervision recommended for younger children due to small parts.

How to Use:

See product listing for step-by-step visual instructions

1. You will need tweezers or one prong of a fork to lift the elastic bands on the underside of the button
2. Create enough space to slide the arm of your glasses through
3. Slide the glasses arm through the opening
4. Adjust the position so it sits comfortably near your ear
5. Repeat on the other side
6. Once fitted, you can easily leave them on your glasses for everyday use

Care Instructions:

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth as needed
- Allow to air dry before use or storage
- Do not bend or overstretch the elastic bands
- Store in the box when not in use
